6 Ounce x 50" Fiberglass Cloth

AeroMarine Products Fiberglass Cloth is a 6-ounce 50" E-Glass Fiberglass Cloth. The fiberglass has a silane finish, so it wets out completely clear. This fiberglass is suitable for waterproofing wood, as a reinforcement on stitch and glue and strip-built boats, or anywhere where a lightweight fiberglass cloth is needed. The fiberglass wets out easily and can be stacked to build thickness. We recommend turning the subsequent layers to provide a cross hatching pattern for extra strength. The fiberglass is generally wet out in a 1:1 rate with the 300/21 epoxy, for example a 1.5 quart kit of the 300/21 epoxy will wet out approximately 9 yards of our fiberglass. This does not account for waste.
