Aluminum Trihydrate is added to AeroMarine epoxies to make an excellent thermal conductor, taking heat away from the exothermic epoxy curing mechanism. Aluminum Trihydrate will add flammability to the resin as well as assisting in smoke suppression. We recommend premeasuring the resin and hardener and mixing the aluminum trihydrate in with the resin prior to adding the hardener to save your work life. Once the aluminum trihydrate is thoroughly mixed into the resin add the hardener.
