## Epoxy Colorants

Add as needed to Epoxy Resin before combining resin and hardener together. Do not use more than the total mix of epoxy or oozing may occur. User determines amount to add. We recommend using 1lb of color per gallon for a full opaque color. If this is your first time adding color tint or pigment to our epoxy system, you may want to test the color effect by adding a spoonful to a small amount of epoxy material and observe the outcome. It may take a few test castings to attain the desired color outcome.
